

Personal Wheelchair Budget National Steering Group Terms of Reference

Purpose and Scope

The Personal Wheelchair Budget National Steering Group **PWBNSG** will work collaboratively with NHS England to support and contribute to the design of the emerging Personal Wheelchair Budget Model and subsequent roll out programme.

The **PWBNSG** scope will be the Personal Wheelchair Budget Programme, membership will include representatives of aligned NHSE Improving Wheelchair Services Programmes of work and where appropriate and relevant aspects of the wider improvement programme will be discussed but the focus and contribution of this group will be on the PWB Programme.

Core Function

The **PWBNSG** will provide expert knowledge and support in the design and delivery of the Personal Wheelchair Budget programme.

Act as a vehicle for clinically led and owned delivery of emerging issues identified by the PWB programme in particular where clinicians require professional support in delivery of the PWB model.

Work as a collective voice for all stakeholders, raising issues and disseminating appropriate information to wider audience.

Support and share the learning from the PWB Programme providing expert advice and or support to relevant work streams within the programme.

Membership

The membership of the **PWBNSG** will consist of a mixture of relevant stakeholders. The PWBNSG will be chaired by Jean Waters, independent to NHS England Jean is a member of the National Wheelchair Leadership Alliance.
